Possible Sources of Asbestos

- Attic & wall insulation that contains vermiculite
- Hot water & steam pipes wrapped in fabric or tape
- Vinyl floor tiles, backings & adhesives
- Furnaces, boilers & furnace ducts wrapped in fabric or tape
- Door gaskets on furnaces, wood & coal stoves
- Walls & floors made of millboard
- Textured paint & patches on walls & ceilings
- Any products made of heat-resistant fabric
- Cement sheets around wood stoves
- Gas-fired fireplaces
- Roofing & siding shingles
- Spray-on insulation



Should I have my home checked for asbestos? If your house was built before 1980, and you suspect it may contain asbestos, the best advice is to hire an asbestos inspector to evaluate the residence.
